

LCOHC PARADE GUIDELINES

In order for our club to provide safety for all riders and spectators and for us to be uniform as a club, the following are guidelines for riding in all parades.

ATTIRE:

Long jeans, blue and white LCOHC shirt, white hat or helmet, and boots. (Helmets will be required for under 18).

GROUND CREW:

People choosing to be on the ground instead of riding a horse will be required to wear the same attire as on horseback. These people will be responsible for distributing candy, flyers, cards, etc. They will also be required to walk the route closest to the curb to protect both riders of our unit and the spectators from darting into our area. When available the ground crew will be carrying the LCOHC banners.

FORMATION:

Horses will be two by two (side by side). There will be a horse and rider carrying the American flag and one (when possible) carrying the Licking County OHC flag. Please, all participants respect this and always ride behind them uniformly. Horses with OHC serapes will ride behind the flag bearers. Feel free to decorate your horse. No double riding, no free lance riding.

STAGING AREA:

If you or your horse becomes restless, dismount and hold your horse in order for all to remain safe.

NOTE:
