- 4. If the park has a log book, please register as this helps keep our parks alive.**
- 5. Please observe park rules regarding Alcohol, Dogs on leashes, and ponied horses on lead line.**
- 6. Please clean up after your horses in campground and parking lot. Dispose of manure in bins when provided.**
- 7. Rides at AEP lands require a one time, lifetime permit.
