

DIRECTIONS TO LCOHC RIDES

All directions are from the Newark area

AEP: CONESVILLE: Rt16 E to Rt83 S. (traffic light) Go 6 miles. Turn right on CR 429, look for sign "Willis Creek Dam", Cr 429 next immediate right. Continue for 0.2 mile. Permit required. Can be downloaded on State OHC website (www.ohiohorsemanscouncil.com) Free camping, water, tie lines, portapots

AEP: McCONNELSVILLE: Rt60 S @ Zanesville to McConnelsville. Left onto Rt 78 E. Continue for 7 miles. Left @ AEP Sign. About 1.8 miles to camp area. Permit required. Camping (free) by permit from AEP, no Water, Shelter house, tie lines, portapots

ALUM CREEK STATE PARK: Rt 16W to Rt37N/NW to Sunbury. Rt36/SR37 W until pass I-71. Turn right @ tractor dealership (CR 10) & go about 1 mile. Turn right on Howard Rd. Camp on Left. Day riding/overnight camping, water, Port-a-john, tie lines

BARKCAMP STATE PARK: I-70 E (toward Wheeling) past Cambridge to exit #208 (Belmont, SR 149). Turn right onto SR 149-go about 1 mile. Follow signs: Left at TR 92, Left into the Park, right to regular campground: Horse sites: 41-67. Fees, water, tie lines, restrooms, horse wash station

BEAVER CREEK STATE PARK: I-70 E toward Wheeling to exit #225 (Bridgeport, Rt7). Go on Rt7 N (follow signs thru business district) to East Liverpool (where SR 30 joins SR7). **Ignore signs to State park.** Outside Liverpool SR 7 exits from SR 30-continue on SR 7 for about 8 miles to Clarkson Road, SR 426. Turn right on Clarkson (HILL). About 2 miles, turn right onto Sprucevale Rd, SR 428 for about 5 miles. Horse Camp on the Left. Tie lines, pit toilets, water. Craft Fair first weekend in October.

BLUE ROCK STATE PARK: Rt60 S @ Zanesville to Duncan Falls. Turn left on CR45. 5 miles to trail head. Private camps, day riding at Park Trailhead. No water, no restrooms, day riding only

BRIDGE OF DREAMS: SR13 N to SR62 N through Danville. $\frac{1}{2}$ mi past Danville turn right onto Buckeye Rd. Parking area #1 past tractor dealership/small lot/keep to left/do not block driveway; #2 parking area = 3rd drive/road past Danville; turn right onto either Mickley Rd or Hunter Rd-park beside trail at intersection; #3 parking available 2 mi further on 62 N at village of Brinkhaven; #4 parking @ Bridge-turn left @ Village Park (Brinkhaven Rd) beside the river-use left driveway-stay on driveway/low section/wet. No facilities/tight parking

BUCK CREEK: I-70 W → Springfield. Exit# 62 (40 W). Continue on 40W for 1 mile. Turn right onto Bird Rd. Turn right onto Old Columbus Rd, Turn left onto Grant Rd -several miles to Horse Parking on Left.

BURR OAK STATE PARK: R13 South to New Lexington & continue on SR 13/37 East. Turn right (South) at junction of R13, 37, 93 onto SR 13. 4 miles past Corning turn Left into the Park. Continue about 1½ miles on the Park Rd. Horseman's Camp on the Left BEFORE regular camping/overflow on right. Enter into campgrounds at second entrance. Water for horses, picket lines, toilets ¼ mi up the road. Showers @ campground

CAESAR CREEK STATE PARK: I-70 W→I-270 S→I-71 S → Exit 45(SR 73). West on 73 toward Waynesville. Cross reservoir bridge, Park Office. Turn right onto Furnas-Oglesby Rd. Horse Camp on right.

DEER CREEK STATE PARK: I70 W→I71 S toward Cincinnati. Exit #84 (Rt56, Mt Sterling)- continue to Mt Sterling. Take Rt207S. Turn left onto Rt62 (Dawson-Yankeetown Rd). Park entrance on right- take 2nd entrance. Follow signs to Horseman's Camp

DILLON STATE PARK: Rt 16 E → Rt 146 S about 7 miles. (OR I-70 E to Zanesville →Rt 146 North. Turn left on Clay Littick Dr.) Turn right at light on Clay Littick Dr. Continue about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, past Park Office. Turn right toward Beach & Camping (about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile). Turn left at sign for Horse Area; up hill to parking lot. Water, toilets, tie line, picnic tables. Water is shut off November 1st turned back on in the Spring.

EAST FORK STATE PARK: I-71 S→I-275 E (Cincinnati)→ Rt32 E (Exit #63B). Continue 10 miles to Half-Acre Rd. Turn right, go through Afton. Turn left onto Old Rt 32. Turn right into Camp @ Alexander Rd. Turn left onto Kain Rd. Horse Camp is on Left. Electricity, showers, toilets, water

GREAT SEAL STATE PARK: Rt37 S to Lancaster→Rt22W→Rt159S about 20 miles to Kinnikinnick. Left (E) onto Rt 180. About $\frac{1}{2}$ mile (just past RR bridge) turn right onto Sulphur Springs Rd→ Go past Delano Rd. Turn left into Park & Horse Area. Water, toilets

HARRISON STATE FOREST: Rt36 E (toward Port Washington) which becomes Rt250 E. Continue through Scio & turn right onto Rt 9South for 3 miles → T-185 (small sign on right for Campground). Pit toilets, tie lines, no water, picnic tables

HOCKING STATE FOREST: Rt 37 S to Lancaster. Rt 33 S/E toward Logan → about 15 miles to Rt 180 - turn right. Turn left onto Rt 678 which ends at Rt 374. Take sharp right turn onto Rt 374 & go about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Keifel Road (Horse Camp sign) - turn left. State Horse Camp is on the right. Water, pit toilets, tie areas

3 Reasons Horse Camp: Continue as above but turn left on Cream Ridge Rd (about 2 miles before Gibisonville on Rt 678. Caution: curve & crest in road). Continue straight at the Y. Look for private property signs. Reservation only: 740 380-2729 Electric, stalls

Palmerosa Horse Camp: Continue as for State Camp but continue on Keifel Road for several more miles. 740 385-3799 Toilets, water, tie areas, showers

HUESTON WOODS STATE PARK: I-70 W toward Indiana to Exit# 19 (Eaton, SR 127). Rt127 S through Eaton to Camden (about 15 miles). Turn right onto Rt 725 W → Rt 177 S. Horse Camp on 4-Mile Valley Rd off Rt 177. Water, pit toilets

INFIRMARY MOUND PARK: Rt 37 South of Granville. Park in large gravel lot in back near Lake Levee. No Fees, water, shelter house, picnic tables, day use only

JEFFERSON LAKE STATE PARK: Rt16 E to Coshocton (becomes Rt36). Continue on 16/36 E to Rt250 E to Cadiz. Rt22 E to Wintersville. Exit at Rt43 (Wintersville, Carrollton) & go past Richmond. **Do not turn into Park at the entrance: steep, windy roads.** Continue on Rt43 to East Springfield. **Horse Camp:** Turn right onto Salem 219 (small road just past E. Springfield sign). Can't use regular camping area anymore, must use horse camp. Water, pit toilets, dump, showers available

LOBDELL RESERVE: Rt161 W to Rt37 N→Alexandria. At the light, turn right on Liberty Rd. Go 2-3 miles. Park on right. Water for horses only. Day use only, portapot

MALABAR FARM STATE PARK: Rt13 N→Rt95 through Fredericktown & Butler to Rt603. Turn Left onto Rt603→Left on Pleasant Valley Rd. Turn left into Park-Bromfield Rd. which turns right & becomes East Hastings Rd. Continue on bearing Left at the Y. Horse camp on left. Water, toilets

MOHICAN STATE PARK: Rt13 N→ Mt. Vernon→Rt3N→Left on Rt97 at the light. Horse Camp located on Left about 5 miles. Water, pit toilets, camping only with permission, tie lines. Day use area on right-tie lines.

PAINT CREEK STATE PARK: Rt37 S to Lancaster→Rt22W to Rt159S→Rt23S to Chillicothe. Go through Chillicothe-bear right at the light to Rt50W through Bainbridge. Pass Park Office. Turn right on Upp Rd. 1 mile to Horse Camp. Fees, water, tie lines, toilets

PERRY STATE FOREST: SR13S thru Somerset pass SR669 look for a golf course on the right hand side of the road. Buckeye Valley Rd will be on the left. Go PAST Buckeye Valley Rd. Take first road to the left (large pond will be on the right hand side with dark fence around it). Stay to the left and look for the Beagle Club on left. Park in the Beagle Club parking area. Shelter house/picnic tables, Bathrooms are usually locked, NO WATER.

PIKE LAKE STATE PARK/TANGLEWOOD ACRES: Rt37 S→Lancaster→Rt22 W→Rt159 S→Rt23 S to Chillicothe. Go through Chillicothe. Bear right onto Rt50 toward Bainbridge. 1 mile before Bainbridge turn left on Potts Hill Rd (sign for Tanglewood) After steep hill, Potts Hill turns left-turn right onto Pike Lake Rd (toward Park). About 3-4 miles Tanglewood Acres on right before Park. Water, tie lines, toilets, showers, restaurant. Reservations recommended. (740) 493-3142-Joyce

SALT FORK STATE PARK: I-70 E → Cambridge →I-77 N →2nd exit (#47;Rt 22). Turn right onto Rt 22→8 miles. Turn left into Park. Follow Park Rd past Beach, Camping areas, Lodge to Horse Camp on right. Fees, water, pit toilets, tie lines

SCIOTO TRAILS STATE PARK: Rt37 S →Lancaster →Rt2 W →Rt159 S→Rt 23 S through Chillicothe. Turn left on Rt372 into Park. Turn left (past Lake Rd) to Stoney Creek Rd past Park Office. Parking on left. Day riding only. Stream. No toilets.

SHAWNEE STATE FOREST: Rt37S →Lancaster →Rt 2 2W→Rt159 S→Rt23 S past Chillicothe, Waverly, Piketon. At Lucasville turn right to Rt 34B 2 miles to Rt104S 15 miles to Rt73 (turn right-West). Take 1st county road to left **after** Lombardsville (Rt371) = Bear Creek Rd. 3 miles (narrow, curvy) to Left on Pond Rd FR4. Horse camp is 1 mile on right. Stream.

STONE CHURCH: Rt13 S to New Lexington → Rt93 S through Bristol & McCuneville into Wayne. Turn right at Old Town Rd (CR38, coal yard on corner; small sign). Horse camp on right, about 2 miles Water for horses only, pit toilet, covered paddock/stalls Fees & Permit is required.

TAFT RESERVE: Linnville Rd South from Rt 13 (intersection by dog pound) to Left at Flint Ridge Rd. Entrance $\frac{3}{4}$ mile on right. Day use only, pit toilet, tie rails. No Water

TAR HOLLOW STATE PARK: Rt 37 S →Lancaster →Rt 22 W →Rt159 S→Rt 23 S → Rt 50 East. 10 miles to Rt 327 (turn Left) & go about 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Poe Run Rd. Turn left - 3 miles to Horse Camp. No fees, water, pit toilets

WAYNE NATIONAL FOREST: Permits required. Closed 12/16-4/14. Gray diamond trail markers.

DEAN: Rt37 S→Lancaster→Rt22 W→Rt159 S→Rt23 S through Chillicothe, Waverly to Piketon. Turn left onto Rt32 E toward Jackson. Right onto Rt93 S for about 30 miles. Turn Left into Park on Rt373. Trailhead Parking on left.

LAKE VESUVIUS: Rt13 S→New Lexington→Rt93 S through Logan, McArthur, Jackson, Oak Hill, Pedro. At Ellisonville turn left onto CR 29. Horse camp on left.

STONE CHURCH: Rt13 S to New Lexington → Rt93 S through Bristol & McCuneville into Wayne. Turn right at Old Town Rd (CR38, coal yard on corner; small sign). Horse camp on right, about 2 miles Water for horses only, pit toilet, covered paddock/stalls Fees & Permit is required.

ZALESKI STATE FOREST: Rt37 S to Lancaster→Rt33 S to McArthur. Turn left onto Rt50 E. After 5-6 miles (about 1 mile past Rt 278) & just before Roadside Rest Area take CR29 to Left (Horseman's Camp sign). Follow CR29 about 4 miles past several intersections, following signs. At a bend in road to left, take gravel road to the right (small sign). Horse Camp is about ½ mile on right. Dirty pond water, pit toilet, some tie lines. Group area: posts/no ties, no water. Portapot
